



Band Booster Meeting Minutes

February 6, 2018

Due to middle school bands using band hall and cafeteria, meeting was moved to A115. Signs posted in cafeteria.

Meeting called to order by Booster President Teri Snowden at 6:38pm.

Teri welcomed everyone back after the holidays. Busy weekend coming up with SVHS band hosting the Solo and Ensemble contest on Saturday, February 10.

Due to limited copies of previous minutes, Teri Snowden asked for attendees to review the minutes from the band website and from the available copy. She also asked for attendees to review the Treasurer's report.

Treasurer Report:

Treasurer Elaine Olaez went through the itemized treasurer's report.

- SNAP Fundraiser – all income is deposited – approximately \$12,000. Thank you to Kathy Wilson! Elaine mentioned that although monies are donated from parents, some employers match that amount as well.
- Spirit Booth – all income is deposited.
- Concessions – income/expenses will come in this weekend after the Solo/Ensemble contest. Amy White will be in contact with Elaine.
- Treasurer's Account – will have more expenses this year. The tax return has been completed.
- Adjunct instructors, Concessions, and Scholarships – are still to come in. *Adjunct instructors* expenses are about half of what was budgeted but are projected to be closer to budget by the end of the year.
- Band banquet – may receive a donation for expenses.
- Silent Auction – Elaine had a question about a \$420 deposit dated Nov 7. She and Pam Millard conferred and determined it was for Silent Auction.

Elaine reminded the committee chairs to be thinking of their budget line items for the May booster meeting, which is the budget meeting.

Teri asked for a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. Sandi Waclawczyk motioned and Carrie Fisher seconded.

Teri asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Monique Pennington motioned and Dana Keith seconded.

Band Director's report:

Mr. Boening was not in attendance due to illness.

New Business:

Solo and Ensemble contest is this Saturday, February 10. Teri thanked everyone who had signed up to volunteer. Volunteers are still needed for an usher position for the 12:30 to 5:00pm shift. Those who signed up for the early morning (7:30am) usher shift will meet in the library at 7:30am with Mr. Boening. Amy White is in charge of concessions and stated that everything is ordered. There will be breakfast tacos in the morning.
